This is a warrant for 120 acres of land near Winamac, Pulaski County, Indiana. Made out to Frederick Hexamer, private in Captain McKinstry's Company, 2nd Regiment, U. S. Infantry, for service in the Mexican War, and dated 1 July 1851, it is assigned to John Strawman. Neither man's name occurs in available Pulaski County histories or listings.
