#### **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

John Thomas Fritsche was born to Reinhold Fritsche and Margaret Gunger on 14 November 1889 in Indiana. He graduated from Shortridge High School in 1906. On 5 September 1908, Fritsche filed a patent application for a mower. The U.S. Patent Office patented the J.T. Fritsche mower on 12 October 1909. Fritsche married Ethel Hasely on 23 August 1911 in Marion County, Indiana. He was listed as working as a credit manager at a department store and as a building contractor. In 1961, he was registered as a Public Accountant in Ohio. Fritsche died on 27 August 1978 in Avon, Ohio.

Christian Fritsche married Emma M. Wilson on 13 April 1874. In March 1885, the couple signed a mortgage with Wilbur A Hanna for two hundred and twenty dollars. Later, in May of the same year, they signed a mortgage with John S. Spann and Co., Real Estate, Loan and Insurance Agents, for three hundred dollars. They paid off the loan in September 1888.
