## **BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH**

John W. Turner, of Columbus, Indiana enlisted March 7<sup>th</sup>, 1862 into Company C of the 6<sup>th</sup> Indiana Volunteer Regiment for a three year term of service. He died in Gallatin, Tennessee of disease on December 24<sup>th</sup>, 1862.

### SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This small collection consists of one letter and one envelope sent from John W. Turner of the 6<sup>th</sup> Volunteer Regiment in Jackson County Alabama home to his wife on July 26<sup>th</sup>, 1862. In his letter, Turner writes about past correspondence with his wife, continuing on to tell her about the shortage of supplies and that this letter is written on his last scrap of paper. He also suggests she move in with her parents before the winter sets in, promises to send her money and sends his love to his children.
