HISTORICAL SKETCH

The Jordan Family YMCA was established in 1954 at 4153 N. College Avenue. Arthur Jordan, a businessman and philanthropist, gave the local YMCA land for buildings. In 1960, construction began on the YMCA's new location in the Nora community in Indianapolis, Indiana, where it continues to operate. In the 1960s, the center ran a Jr. High Canteen that students could join. The YMCA held regular dances for the canteen members each month.
