## **SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE**

This collection consists of two letters.

The first letter was written by Luther Martin to the auditor of Kosciusko County, Indiana, requesting a list of delinquent properties for sale, 23 March, 1872.

The second letter written by W. & J. Braden, a lithographer in Indianapolis who specialized in blank book production and is addressed to an unknown recipient "Sir" informing him that his blank settlement sheets are ready, and also that they have blank auditor reports and superintendent sheets ready if he needs any, 12 April 1869.
