BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Mae Geneva Huffman Jackson (December 12, 1901-January 3, 1988) was born in Clerktown, Johnson County, Indiana to James and Florence May Burgess Huffman. She was the oldest of three children; her brothers were Claude and Harry. She married Oral W. Jackson, a farmer, on March 23, 1927, and they resided in Washington Township, Shelby County, Indiana. The couple had one child, Virginia Mae, born June 29, 1930. Prior to her marriage, according to pictorial evidence in the photograph album, Mae worked in downtown Indianapolis in the Ordinary Department at the Public Savings Insurance Company, which was located at 147 E. Market St.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

This album contains snapshots of Mae Geneva Huffman Jackson, her family, friends, and co-workers. Most snapshots were taken in Indiana, particularly in Central Indiana—downtown Indianapolis, Beech Grove, and Garfield Park, as well as Acton, Flat Rock, Hope, Edinburgh, Madison, and Walnut Grove. The snapshots document picnics, fish fries, farm life, family reunions, fun with co-workers at the Public Savings Insurance Co. in Indianapolis, scenery, and travel outside of Indiana to Louisville, Baltimore, Niagara Falls, Atlantic City, and Chicago. Most individuals in the album, if they are identified, are only done so by their first names.
