HISTORICAL SKETCH

Oakdale School is located on the U.S. Army's Jefferson Proving Grounds in Jefferson, Ripley, and Jennings counties in Indiana. The school is on the west side of Morgan Road, which was historically called Paper Mill Road and on the north side of Firing Line Road, historically called Calloway Road.

The one-room school was opened in 1829. Originally the building was constructed of hewn logs. The current stone school building was constructed in 1869. Oakdale was still in operation when the U.S. Army acquired the land for the Proving Grounds in early 1941.
