#### HISTORICAL/BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

The WKBF radio broadcasting station was first opened in Indianapolis in 1926 by Noble Butler Watson and his brother Carl Watson. It was one of the first Indianapolis radio stations to join a major network broadcast after airing the Dempsey-Tunney fight in 1927 over NBC. The call letters were changed to WIRE in November, 1935.

Odes E. Robinson was born in Whiteville, Tennessee on October 3rd, 1911. He moved to Indianapolis in 1933 and began working as the chief engineer for WKFB where he became the youngest chief engineer of a metropolitan broadcasting studio in the United States. He made a name for himself within the broadcasting field for his work in building transmitting equipment. Odes died in Broward, Florida on March 29th, 1985.
