Aiken was a farmer in Vanderburgh and Warrick counties, Indiana.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The papers consist principally of Aiken's correspondence, legal documents, and financial records relating to farming and the shipping of agricultural products from Newburgh (Warrick County) and Evansville (Vanderburgh County), 1850–86. Also included are letters from merchants in Lawrenceburg (Dearborn County) and New Orleans, La.; and Aiken family legal documents (1833–50).
