HISTORICAL SKETCH

The county council for the Parke County Conservation Clubs consisted of the following clubs: Sugar Creek, Montezuma, Lodi, Rockville (sometimes spelled Rockeville), Tangier, Penn Township, Turkey Run, and Bridgeton. The council met the last Monday night of each month, usually at the Sheriff's office in the Court House. At times different clubs would participate in competitions, such as pest elimination, where they eliminated sparrows, starlings, mice, pigeons, hawks, owls, rats, moles, crows, and ground hogs. The council also voted on different conservation issues, such as whether fox hunters could use dogs, mussel dragging, seining minnows to sell, and whether they should sponsor events for 4H Clubs.
