The document was sent by the State Auditor's office to county auditors on 20 June 1843. The copy in this collection was sent to the Perry County auditor. Information in the document includes an additional tax of two mills or two-tenths of a cent to be added to go to the support of a Deaf and Dumb Asylum. The majority of the document deals with collecting delinquent taxes.
