SKETCH

In the 1900 Presidential Election, the Republican Party candidate William McKinley received 336,063 votes and won the state of Indiana with 50.60% over Democratic candidate William Jennings Bryan, who received 46.62% of the votes. Indiana had fifteen electoral college votes at that time. Charles S. Hernly was Chairman of the Indiana Republican State Committee with Joseph B. Kealing as Vice Chairman, and Warren Bigler as Secretary.
