BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Samuel H. Hoshour (1830-1892) was born in either Maryland or Virginia and came to Cambridge City, Wayne County, Indiana in the 1840s with his family. Hoshour became a druggist in Cambridge City and was married to Frances Hall. He was also a member of the Society of Friends (Quaker) religion.
