BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Irene Mary Taggart Young was born in 1882 to Thomas K. Taggart (1856–1929) and Eva Bryant Taggart (1853–1937). Thomas K. Taggart was an Irish immigrant who was an influential political figure in Indianapolis. He served as Auditor of Marion County from 1886 to 1894, Mayor of Indianapolis from 1895 to 1901, and member of the Democratic National Committee from 1900 to 1916.

Irene married William Jackson Young (1881–1937), a physician from Kentucky. In 1920, the pair had their only child, Thomas Taggart Young. Thomas joined the Royal Canadian Air Force as a pilot during World War II, but sustained fatal head injuries during a flying accident in India and died on November, 15, 1942.

Irene Taggart Young died in 1970.
