BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

On June 26, 2014, Timothy Brown and Tracy Brown-Salsman became the first couple in Martin County, Indiana to be granted a same-sex marriage license and wed. This came during an upheaval of earlier Indiana legislation banning same-sex marriage. Indiana restricted marriage to male-female couples by statute in 1996 and, in 1997, legislation denied recognition to same-sex relationships established in other jurisdictions.

However, in 2014, a series of court decisions overturned earlier legislation. *Baskin v. Bogan* was a key lawsuit. The lawsuit challenged the state's position on granting marriage licenses to same-sex couples and it won a favorable decision in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Indiana on June 25, 2014. However, on June 27, 2014, a stay on the decision was requested by Attorney General Greg Zoeller and granted by the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Seventh Circuit. During the brief window between the *Baskin v. Bogan* decision and the Seventh Circuit stay, a number of couples, including Brown and Salsman, were granted licenses. Brown and Salsman, by 2014, had shared a nearly 26 year relationship. On June 26, 2014, the two were officially wed in the Martin County Court in Shoals, Indiana. Judge Lynne E. Ellis officiated the ceremony. The couple was the first to be granted a marriage license and wed in Martin County.

On June 28, Governor Mike Pence stated that the marriages initiated between June 25–28 should be ignored. The couple began encountering issues with the Social Security Administration Office. After their wedding, they had hoped to merge their individual last names into Brown-Salsman. However, with the granted stay, they existed within a legal gray area along with other couples married during the short June window. However, the Seventh Circuit of Appeals, upheld the *Baskin v. Bogan* decision. The court motioned for a stay of ruling until the U.S. Supreme Court could consider. The Supreme Court declined to consider an appeal on October 6, 2014. This allowed the Seventh Circuit Court of Appeals to issue and implement its decision requiring Indiana to license and recognize same-sex marriages. After this decision, the couple was able to have their official name change approved by the Social Security Administration, which they did on October 7, 2014.

In addition to advocating for marriage equality, The Brown-Salsmans have been involved with AIDS activism and they continue to raise awareness and support for the LGBTQ+community in rural Southern Indiana. To this end, they were the driving force in the first Pride celebration in Loogootee, Indiana, held on June 10th, 2023 in the town square. After the success of the event, the Loogootee PrideFest, represented by the Indiana ACLU, have been in litigation with the City of Loogootee over the Common Council's refusal to issue permits for the Pride celebration to be held on the square again in 2024.
