HISTORICAL SKETCH

Founded by Indiana native Katie Josway in 2016, Women of Indianapolis Arts (WOIA) is an independent organization for female and female-identifying artists. Its missions include supporting and inspiring fellow women artists and the community, and empowering the next generation of female artists. It includes women from a variety of disciplines who actively contribute to the arts and culture of Indianapolis. This includes visual and performing artists, social activists, event organizers, venue owners, journalists, etc. The group is run by volunteers.

Josway is also the director of the organization. She is a songwriter and the vocalist and rhythm guitarist for the band Gypsy Moonshine. She also writes poetry and designs and creates handmade jewelry.
