HISTORICAL SKETCH

Wright-Bachman Lumber Company was incorporated in Indianapolis in May, 1903, by William N. Wright, Frederick Bachman, and Frederick M. Bachman. Their business was conducted at Portland, Ashley County, Arkansas with Wright serving as the agent, while Indianapolis served as the corporate office. Later stockholders included Herman Lieber, Henry and Samuel Rauh, Frank Edenharter, Henry Hornbrook, and Joseph Bell.
